

Course Overview

ENA'S New Instructor Path is a blended learning program that includes online adult learning and instruction, live practice, mentorship and monitored Instruction.

Course Requirements

An unrestricted RN license (send copy with registration).

1. Current ENPC Provider status (send copy with registration).
2. **Instructor Potential Recommendation and Checklist** from the **ENPC Course Director**.

The following additional criteria are recommended:

1. At least two years' experience in nursing care of the pediatric patient.
2. Experience in teaching.

Important Notice for Instructor Potentials

To ensure successful completion of the course, please be aware of the following:

1. If it has been longer than 90 days since your Provider course, pre-testing is required within 28 days of the Instructor Course.
2. Watch for an email from courseops@ena.org with instructions to complete the online examination.
3. You will have one attempt to score 90% on the exam.
4. You **MUST** print the **completion certificate** as your ticket to enter the Instructor Course.
 - If you are unsuccessful, please contact the Course Director to withdraw from the Instructor Course.
5. The Psychomotor Skills (PNP) test will be conducted at **0730 on the morning of the Instructor course**.
6. You will have one attempt to score 90% on the skills test.
 - If you are unsuccessful, you will be withdrawn from the Instructor Course.

NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN IF UNSUCCESSFUL AT PROVIDER TESTING.

Online Requirements

Complete the Instructor Course Online Modules. Contact the Course Director immediately if you have not received access from the ENA.

- Students will **NOT** be allowed to attend the class if the pre-course modules are incomplete.
- You **MUST** print the **completion certificate** as your ticket to **enter** the Instructor Course.

ENPC Instructor Candidates

A State Trauma Committee member or an approved designee (ICER) must evaluate the instructor candidate in accordance with the ENA Administrative Procedures.
